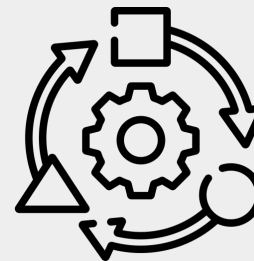

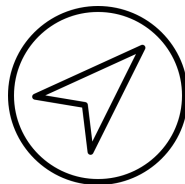

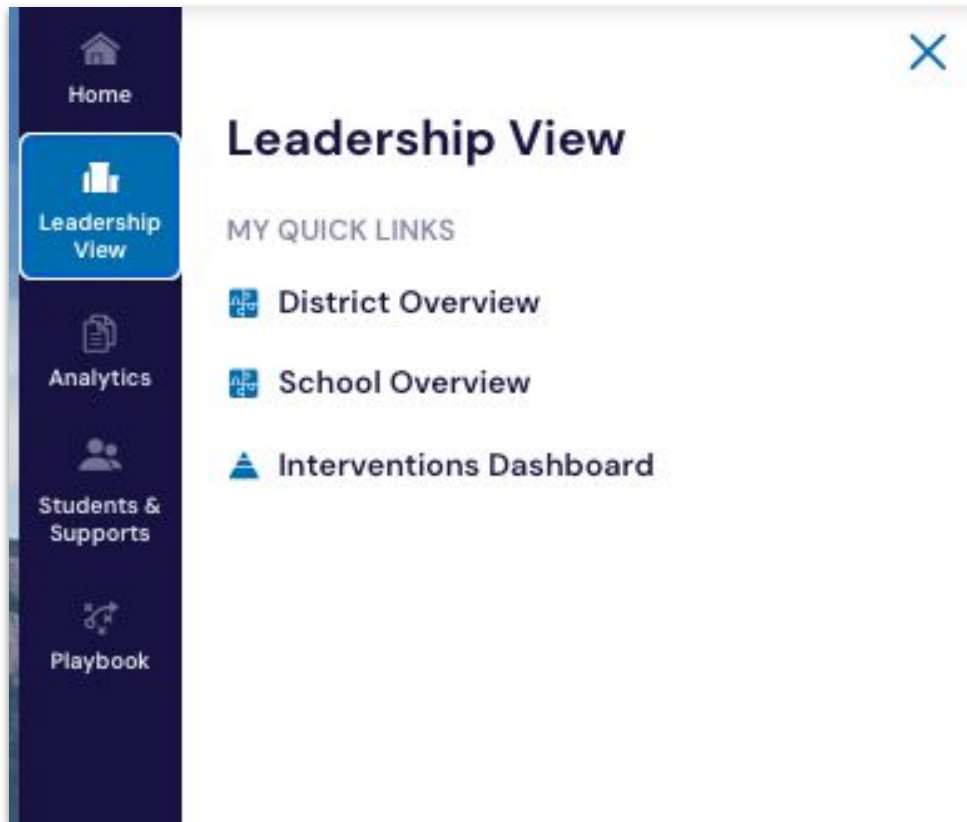

### What is the Attendance indicator?

This indicator provides a quick view of students' status based on their Attendance. This can help you determine which students need the most intervention or support.

### What do the colors and labels mean?

- Very Low Risk**  
Student has attended 99% or more of school days this year.
- Low Risk**  
Student has attended 95% or more, and less than 99% of school days this year.
- Some Risk** ▲  
Student has attended 90% or more, and less than 95% of school days this year.
- High Risk** ●  
Student has attended less than 90% of school days this year.

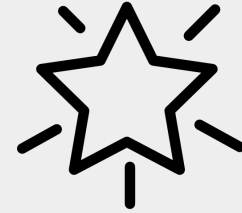

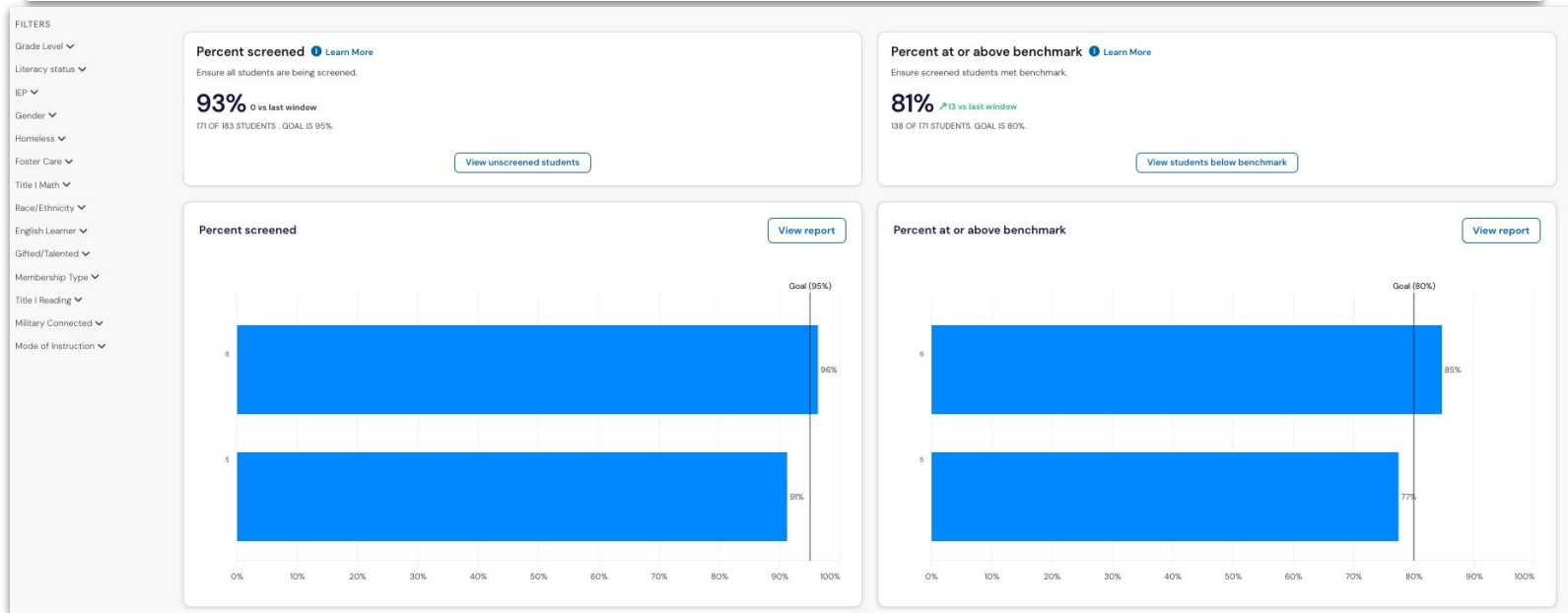

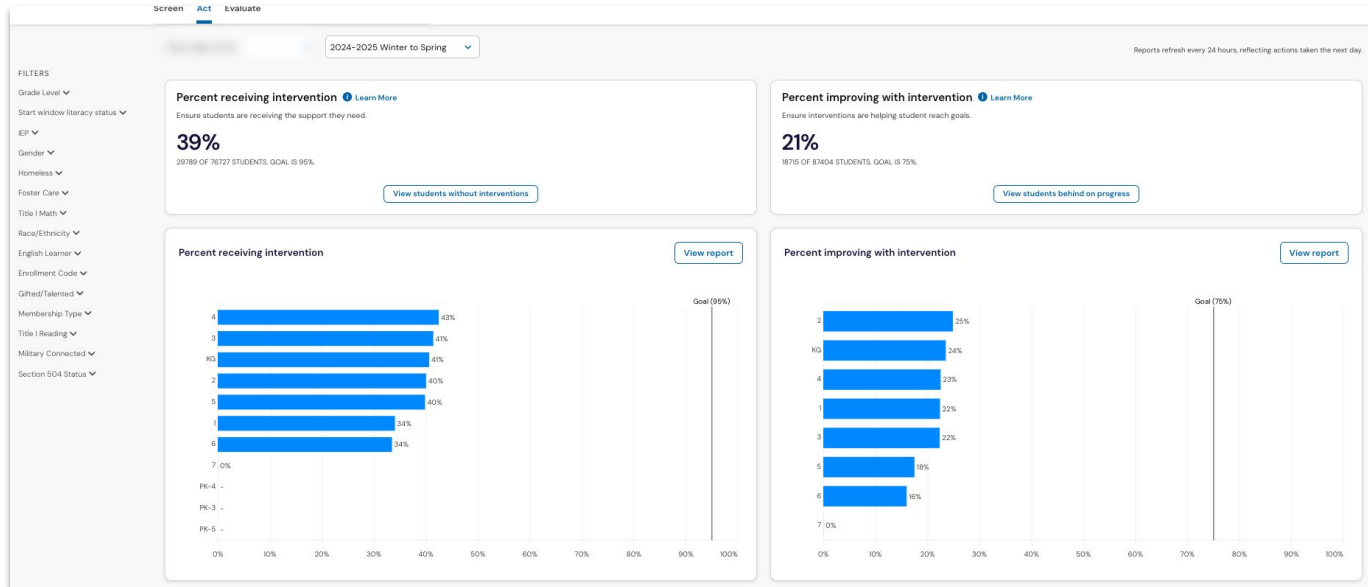

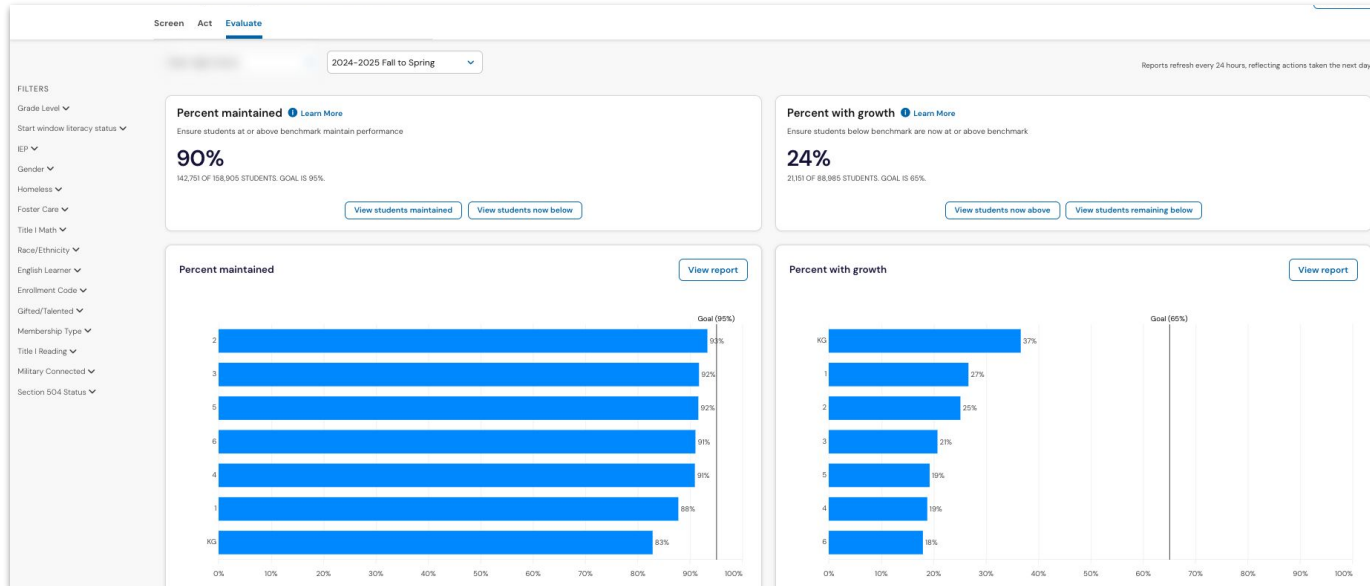
